Director:

Regional Update:

- FY15-HSGP

Walterhouse-Workbook for FY15 projects has been submitted our proposed projects are local planner, dive equipment and equipment to enhance interoperable radio communications and backup. The allocation to the state for the FY-15 HSGP is the same as the FY-14 allocation.

Walterhouse-Local projects have been approved the Active 911 project was combined with the 800Mhz portable radio project as there was not sufficient time remaining to implement the Active 911 project.
